ENGLISH PLUS EXPLORE LONDON

15 hours/week

We use a special short course syllabus which focuses on improving the core skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening through immersive activities and project work. Lessons are interactive and engaging, providing a natural platform for students to practise their English. After lunch, students will be taken on afternoon excursions in and around London, providing the opportunity to practise their English language skills in reallife contexts. Excursions may include Trafalga Square, St Paul's Cathedral, Tower Bridge, Buckingham Palace and more!
